

How long should fiber optic cable splices typically be left open



Overview

In practical deployments, fiber optic splicing is not performed in open environments. To protect spliced fibers, manage excess cable length, and ensure long-term stability, splicing is typically completed inside a fiber enclosure equipped with dedicated fiber. Splices are critical points in the optical fibre network, because they strongly affect the quality and lifetime of links. High quality in splicing is usually characterized by low splice loss and tensile strength.
