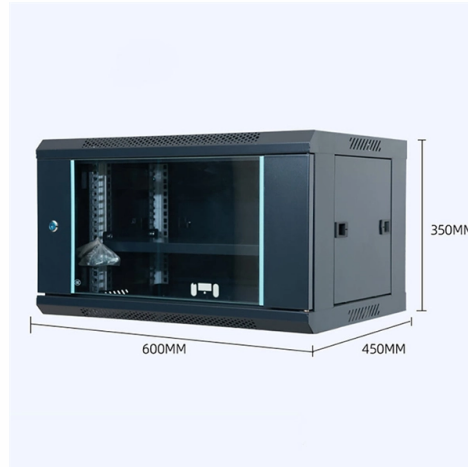


How many circuits are needed for a 100-square-meter electrical distribution box



Overview

A 100 m² house requires a minimum of 10-14 electrical circuits. This includes 2-3 lighting circuits, 3-4 general-purpose socket circuits, 2 kitchen circuits, and 3-4 circuits for special devices such as a washing machine, dishwasher, or heating boiler. Before determining the required number of circuits and associated calculations, let's define and differentiate between branch circuits, general-purpose lighting branch circuits, and individual branch circuits. According to NEC Article 100 – Definitions: Branch Circuit: Refers to the conductors. Example: Need a circuit for your 1,800W microwave?
