

How many fiber optic cables does each router need

Typically, a single fiber optic cable is sufficient for a router to function properly in a standard residential setup.

Residential Setup

For most home fiber-optic internet connections, the fiber optic cable from your ISP terminates at an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which converts the optical signal into an electrical signal that your router can use . In this configuration:

- One fiber optic cable runs from the wall outlet to the ONT.
- The ONT then connects to your router via an Ethernet cable.
- The router distributes internet to your devices via Wi-Fi or Ethernet. This means that for a typical home, only one fiber strand is required to provide full internet functionality.

Duplex vs. Single Fiber

Some setups use duplex fiber cables, which contain two fibers: one for transmitting and one for receiving data. Even in this case, the router itself still only interfaces with the ONT or a fiber-ready port, so the user does not need multiple separate cables for basic operation .
