

How many gigabit routers are needed for a 1 Mbps fiber optic connection

Number of Devices Even with multiple devices connected, a single router is sufficient for a 1 Mbps plan. However, the total bandwidth is shared among all devices, so each device will get only a fraction of the 1 Mbps if multiple devices are active simultaneously. For example, if two devices are streaming or downloading at the same time, each may only achieve around 0.5 Mbps.

Network Coverage If your home is large or has multiple floors, you might consider Wi-Fi extenders or a mesh system to improve coverage, but this does not require additional routers for speed purposes. The single gigabit router can still serve as the main hub.

Practical Advice Using a high-end gigabit router for a 1 Mbps connection is technically overkill, but it ensures future-proofing if you upgrade your internet plan...
