

How many meters should the fiber optic cable trays be spaced



Overview

Under normal circumstances, the distance between the support arms of the cable tray should be about 1.5 m – 3 m, and should be verified according to specific conditions. The charter of the FOA was to promote professionalism in fiber optics through education, certification, and. The NEC requires that cable trays must be supported by members at an interval specified by the cable tray manufacturer, but not more than 5 feet for horizontal runs to support the weight of the cables and other loads. The NEC has a requirement for ladder-type cable trays. Article 770 does not refer to 300. For the installation of single conductor cables sized 1/0 AWG to 4/0 AWG in industrial establishments, the NEC specifies the maximum allowable rung spacing for the cable. The maximum horizontal distance shall be 76-meters (250 ft).
