

How many pipes can a distribution box hold

- **Local Codes:** Some jurisdictions specify the maximum number of outlets or require specific spacing between pipes to ensure even distribution .
- **Flow Control Features:** Some boxes include internal baffles or adjustable risers to manage flow, which can slightly limit the number of pipes that can be installed
