

How much does a 50-meter telecommunications tower weigh

Transmission tower weight per meter varies dramatically by voltage level: 35kV towers average 100-180 kg/m, 66kV systems run 150-250 kg/m, 110kV towers range 200-450 kg/m, 220kV structures reach 350-600 kg/m, and 500kV ultra-high voltage towers require 500-800 kg/m.
