

How much spacing should there be between cable trays and cable troughs

The standard horizontal distance between parallel cable trays is at least 0.6 meters, vertical spacing is at least 150 mm, and power and signal trays should be separated by 0.5 meters unless shielded.

Horizontal Spacing
