

How should optical cables be coiled



Overview

The rule is to coil the fiber once after each splicing and heat shrinking of one or several optical fibers in fiber optic sleeve or optical fibers in a branch direction optical cable. Therefore, it is necessary to avoid bird's-nest fiber coiling; to coil fiber well is a meticulous job that requires great patience and does not allow for any sloppiness. Before fiber coiling, the optical cable and pigtail should be pre-processed, and the optical cable and pigtail should be opened. Fiber optic cable is sensitive to excessive pulling, bending, and crush forces. Any such damage may alter the cable's characteristics to the extent that the cable section may have to be replaced.
