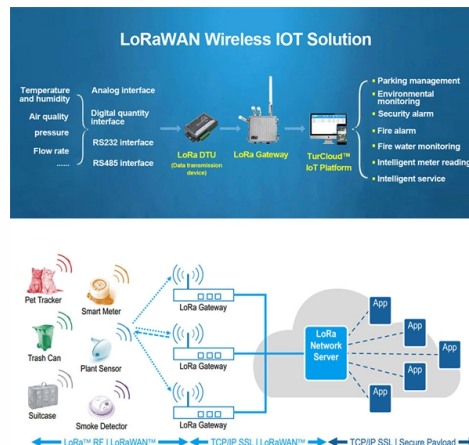


How thick should the cables be inside the cable tray for a better look

Cable Tray Fill and Aesthetics

The thickness of cables inside a tray should be selected not only for electrical requirements but also for visual organization and airflow. Overly thick or tightly packed cables can look messy, reduce ventilation, and make maintenance difficult. A good rule of thumb is to calculate the total cross-sectional area of all cables and ensure it does not exceed the tray's allowable fill percentage, usually 50% for single-layer installations. This leaves room for heat dissipation and future expansion.

Layering and Cable Grouping

- Single-layer arrangement: Place cables side by side without stacking to maintain a clean look and maximize airflow.
- Grouped zones: Separate power, control, and data cables into distinct zones to reduce interference and improve visual clarity.
- Consistent orientation: Align cables in parallel and avoid crossing or twisting, which enhances both aesthetics and safety.
