

How thick should the grounding thickness be for fiber optic cable pulling machines

- Typical Practice: For small to medium fiber optic pulling machines, a copper conductor of 6 AWG to 4 AWG is commonly used, depending on the machine's metallic mass and local code requirements. Larger machines or those with extensive metallic components may require larger conductors to maintain low impedance and ensure safe current dissipation
