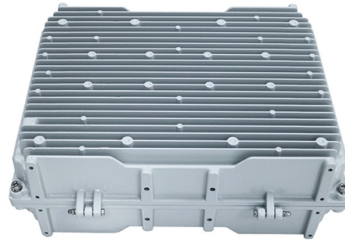


How to configure the escalator electrical distribution box
