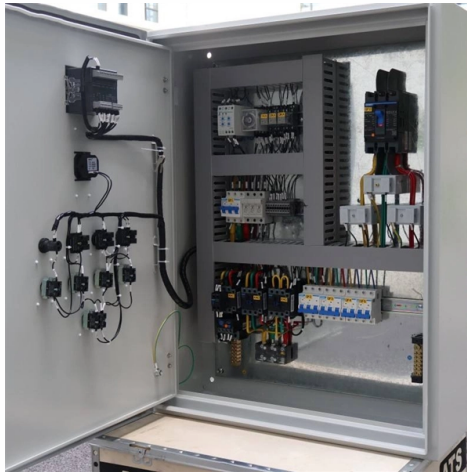


How to define core switches in a data center

Core switches are high-capacity, high-performance switches that form the backbone of a data center network, enabling ultra-fast, reliable, and scalable connectivity between distribution layers and servers.

Role and Functionality

A core switch acts as the central hub of a data center network, aggregating traffic from multiple distribution or aggregation switches and ensuring rapid data transfer across the network with minimal latency and maximum reliability . Unlike access switches, which connect end devices, core switches are optimized for Layer 3 routing, high throughput, and large-scale traffic handling. They are designed to handle East-West traffic between servers and storage systems, as well as North-South traffic to external networks . Core switches typically avoid resource-intensive tasks like deep packet inspection or complex ACLs at the core to maintain ultra-low latency, following the principle that the more intelligence added to the core, the slower it performs . In smaller networks, a collapsed core architecture may combine core and distribution functions into a single high-performance switch layer, simplifying deployment while maintaining efficiency .
