

# How to ground cables in a distribution box



## Overview

Attach a ground wire from one of the threaded studs (A) at the bottom of the housing, to the mounting plate (B). The ground resistance between all system parts shall be  $< 1 \Omega$ . Power from factory ground must be installed by a qualified electrician. Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. 26 mm<sup>2</sup> (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm<sup>2</sup> must be used. This part is covered by National Electrical Code article 250. A subpanel helps distribute electricity throughout your home, but to enjoy this advantage, you must ground it first for safety.
