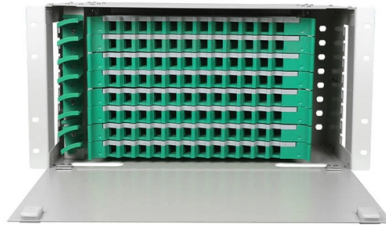

- Cutting the fiber near the source and measuring the output power again.
- Calculating the attenuation per unit length from the difference in power readings....
