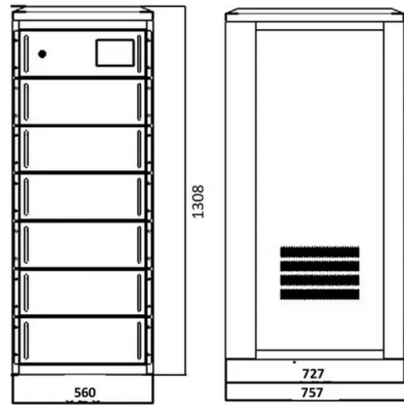


How to test Fiber Channel
