Key Parameters to Test

- Faults and Events – Detects bends, breaks, or splices along the fiber using OTDR (Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer), which is especially important for long-distance or outdoor cables .
- Connector and Endface Quality – Visual inspection identifies contamination, scratches, cracks, or defects that can degrade performance .
- Signal Quality – Evaluates the strength and clarity of the transmitted signal, including bit error rate (BER) for data transmission .

Common Testing Methods

- Visual Inspection: Use fiber inspection probes or microscopes to check connector endfaces for dirt or damage before and after testing .
- Optical Loss Test Set (OLTS): Measures total light loss in a fiber link, simulating network conditions to verify attenuation .
- Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer (OTDR): Sends light pulses through the fiber to locate faults, bends, or splices and measure distance to events
