Overview of Tier I (T1) Data Centers

A Tier I data center is the most basic level of data center infrastructure as defined by the Uptime Institute and IDC standards. It is designed to support IT operations beyond a typical office environment but does not include redundant systems. T1 data centers are suitable for small businesses or non-critical applications where occasional downtime is acceptable .

Key Features

- Infrastructure: Dedicated space for IT systems, including servers, storage, and networking equipment .
- Power Supply: Basic uninterruptible power supply (UPS) to protect against power spikes, voltage dips, and short outages .
- Cooling: Dedicated cooling systems to maintain optimal operating temperatures, operational during normal office hours .
- Backup Power: Engine generators to provide protection against prolonged power outages .
- Availability: Approximately 99.67% uptime, translating to up to 28.8 hours of downtime per year
