Visual Identification

Outer Jacket Color: The fastest way to identify fiber type and potential usage is by the cable's outer jacket color, as defined by the TIA-598-D standard. For example, single-mode fibers often have yellow jackets, while multimode fibers may be orange (OM1/OM2) or aqua (OM3/OM4) for indoor cables. Outdoor cables are typically black, so printed legends on the jacket are necessary to determine fiber type . **Inner Fiber Color Sequence:** Multi-fiber cables use a standardized 12-color sequence to identify individual fibers. Fibers beyond 12 repeat the sequence with a stripe or binder for differentiation. By tracing these colors, technicians can determine which fibers are connected and which may be idle . **Connector Color and Type:** The connector body or boot color indicates fiber mode and polish type (UPC/APC). Unused fibers often have connectors capped or left unconnected in patch panels, making visual inspection a key step .

Labeling and Documentation

Cable Labels: Many networks use printed labels or tags at both ends of the cable to indicate active or idle status. Checking these labels against network documentation can quickly identify unused fibers. **Patch Panel Mapping:** In data centers or telecom rooms, idle fibers are often left unpatched in the panel.
