Cable Selection and Fire Safety

For indoor installations, use cables with flame-retardant jackets, such as riser-rated, plenum-rated, or LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen) cables, depending on the building environment and local fire codes . Plenum-rated cables are required in air-handling spaces and provide higher flame and smoke resistance, while riser-rated cables are suitable for vertical shafts and general horizontal runs. LSZH cables reduce toxic gas emissions in case of fire, making them ideal for enclosed spaces .

Routing in Cable Trays

- Use cable trays or ladder racks to support fiber optic cables along horizontal and vertical paths .
- Maintain proper bend radius to prevent signal loss or fiber damage; follow manufacturer specifications for minimum bend radius .
- Avoid overcrowding: keep the tray fill rate below 40% to allow for future cable additions or maintenance .
- Separate fiber from power cables to reduce electromagnetic interference and ensure safety
