Installing an RCCB involves careful isolation, secure mounting on a DIN rail, correct wiring of live, neutral, and earth connections, and thorough testing to ensure safety.

Before starting, turn off the main power supply and verify that the distribution board is completely de-energized using a multimeter or voltage tester . Wear insulated gloves and safety glasses to protect against accidental electric shock. Only qualified electricians should perform this installation.

- Choose an RCCB with the correct type (AC or A), current rating, sensitivity, and voltage compatible with your load .
- Ensure you have the necessary tools: insulated screwdrivers, wire strippers, pliers, and a multimeter .

- Open the distribution box and locate the DIN rail.
- Hook the top clip of the RCCB onto the rail and push the bottom until it snaps sec...
