

Installation spacing of fire cable trays



Overview

When installing two cable trays in parallel at the same height, the distance between them should be no less than 0. This spacing is crucial for adequate maintenance access, ease of inspection, and ensuring proper airflow for effective heat dissipation. The spacing between trays, whether horizontal or vertical, depends on various factors like cable type, environment, and tray material. Proper installation can significantly reduce electromagnetic interference, prevent fire hazards, and improve overall efficiency. This article provides an in-depth. The National Electrical Manufacturers Association (NEMA) also publishes three consensus standards that apply to the proper manufacture and installation of cable trays: ANSI/NEMA-VE 1-1998, Metal Cable Tray Systems; NEMA-VE 2-1996, Metal Cable Tray Installation Guidelines; and NEMA-FG-1998. Cable tray installation must comply with specific technical standards to ensure electrical safety, system reliability, and long-term maintainability. You'll need to use the right kind of hardware to attach these supports. NEC Article 392 outlines the key rules for installing and maintaining industrial cable tray systems.
