

Installation spacing of vertical supports for cable trays



AI Overview

Vertical supports for cable trays should generally be spaced at intervals of 1.5 to 2 meters, with additional strain relief for long runs to prevent mechanical stress.

General Guidelines

For vertical cable tray runs, supports must be fixed to the building structure to prevent undue mechanical strain on the cables and terminations.
