The fiber end is polished to a physical contact (PC) surface, which may be further enhanced to super (SPC) or ultra (UPC) polish for reduced insertion loss and back-reflection . **Spring Mechanism:** A spring-loaded design ensures that the ferrule maintains consistent contact force when mated with a receptacle. This prevents gaps between fiber cores, minimizing signal loss and reflection . **Threaded Body:** The FC connector features a screw-threaded coupling that secures the connector to the adapter, providing stability in high-vibration environments. A key or alignment feature prevents the ferrule from rotating during mating, maintaining precise core alignment . **Protective Housing:** The external metal or plastic housing protects the ferrule and fiber from mechanical stress, dust, and environmental factors. The screw cap also contributes to dust-proofing and reliable mating .
