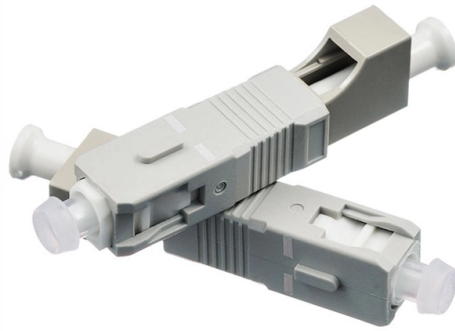


Is fiber optic cable used for the router s WAN port

Why Direct Connection Usually Doesn't Work

Standard home routers are designed to receive electrical Ethernet signals, not optical signals transmitted via fiber. Fiber optic cables carry data as light pulses, which must be converted into electrical signals before a router can process them. This conversion is typically handled by an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) provided by your ISP, which acts as a bridge between the fiber network and your router .

Typical Setup

- **Fiber Cable to ONT:** The fiber optic cable from your ISP connects to the ONT's optical port. This device converts the light signals into standard Ethernet signals .
- **ONT to Router:** Use a high-quality Ethernet cable (Cat6 or Cat6a recommended) to connect the ONT's Ethernet port to the WAN port on your router .
- **Router Configuration:** Power on the router and configure it with your ISP credentials if required. This setup allows your router to distribute the internet connection to your devices via Wi-Fi or LAN ports .
