Fiber Optic Cables

Fiber optic cables transmit data using light signals through thin strands of glass or plastic, making them ideal for high-speed, long-distance communication with minimal signal loss and immunity to electromagnetic interference (EMI) . They are commonly used in telecommunications, data centers, and high-performance networks. Fiber optic cables come in single-mode and multimode types, with single-mode supporting longer distances and multimode optimized for shorter, high-bandwidth connections . Installation and maintenance can be more expensive than copper cables, but they provide superior performance for demanding applications .

Electrical (Copper/Ethernet) Cables

Electrical network cables, often called Ethernet cables, use copper wires to transmit data as electrical signals. Common types include twisted pair cables (Cat5e, Cat6) and coaxial cables . Twisted pair cables reduce electromagnetic interference by twisting the wire pairs, making them suitable for home networks, offices, and short-distance connections . Copper cables are generally more affordable and easier to install than fiber optic cables but have limitations in speed, distance, and susceptibility to EMI
