- Polish styles: UPC (Ultra Physical Contact) for data centers and APC (Angled Physical Contact) for FTTH to minimize back reflection .
- Factory-terminated connectors ensure consistent geometry, low insertion loss, and high return loss compared to field-terminated connectors .
