Regulatory and Safety Standards

National Electrical Code (NEC) Article 314 governs the installation and use of electrical boxes, conduit bodies, and fittings in the U.S., ensuring safety and preventing electrical hazards . Key requirements include:

- **Box Types and Materials:** Boxes can be metallic (steel, aluminum) or non-metallic (plastic, PVC, fiberglass). Metallic boxes must be grounded and bonded to maintain electrical continuity, while non-metallic boxes have limitations when used with metallic raceways .
- **Installation and Fastening:** Boxes must be securely fastened to the structure using approved methods and remain rigid to prevent physical damage. Screws and fasteners must not damage conductors or compromise insulation .
- **Flush Mounting:** Boxes installed in walls or ceilings must be flush with the finished surface to allow proper cover installation and prevent fire spread. Openings around boxes in noncombustible surfaces must not exceed $\frac{1}{4}$ inch .
- **Internal Space:** Boxes must have sufficient depth and internal volume to accommodate devices, splices, and wiring without damaging conductors .
- **Environmental Protection:** Boxes in damp or wet locations must be rated for such conditions, often requiring gaskets or sealed enclosures
