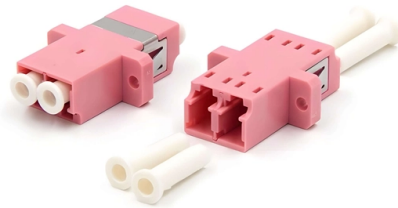


Measuring the loss of optical cables

- Intrinsic losses: caused by the fiber's material properties, including absorption, scattering, and dispersion .

For example, single-mode fiber has typical losses of 0.5 dB/km at 1310 nm and 0.4 dB/km at 1550 nm, while multimode fiber has higher losses, around 3 dB/km at 850 nm .

Methods for Measuring Loss

1. Insertion Loss Testing

This method uses a light source and power meter to measure the total loss from one end of the fiber to the other. The steps include:

- Connect the light source to the fiber input and the power meter to the output.
