Fibre Channel Overview

Fibre Channel (FC) is a high-speed, lossless data transfer protocol primarily used in storage area networks (SANs) to connect servers and storage devices in data centers . It supports multiple topologies, including point-to-point, arbitrated loop, and switched fabric, and can run over optical fiber or copper cabling . FC supports high data rates ranging from 1 Gbps to 128 Gbps, enabling fast and reliable block-level storage communication .

Mesh (Switched Fabric) Topology

A mesh channel in Fibre Channel is typically implemented as a switched fabric topology, where all devices are interconnected through switches . Key characteristics include:

- Simultaneous communication: Multiple nodes can transmit data concurrently, improving efficiency.
- Redundant paths: Provides high availability and fault tolerance by allowing alternate routes between devices.
- Scalability: Switches can be added without downtime, supporting large SAN deployments....
