

Methods for sealing optical cable holes



Overview

The most common fiber splice closure sealing methods include heat-shrink, mechanical, and gel-based sealing. Gel seals utilize a soft gel material that adheres tightly to the cable. connection points is undeniable, not all seals are created equal. Many NEMA and IP-rated potted seals, grommets and cable glands can shield fiber optic components from water spray or temporary submersion at a limited depth, but they fall short of a moisture-tight hermetic seal and will allow gases. 1 Sealing of the fiber optic splice closure (1) Clean the sealing groove around the joint box with alcohol cotton/wipes. (2) Insert the sealing strip into the sealing groove of the lower half of the joint box. Just peel off layers until the module fits. First, it protects against environmental hazards such as moisture, dust, and debris that can damage delicate fiber optic cables.
