- **Traffic Patterns:** Observe bandwidth usage, packet drops, and congestion to optimize performance and plan for capacity upgrades .
- **Redundancy and Uplinks:** Ensure redundant uplinks to aggregation switches are active and monitor inter-switch links to maintain resiliency .
- **Security Monitoring:** Detect unknown devices, abnormal traffic spikes, or suspicious port behavior to prevent unauthorized access .
