- Water-blocking layers: Prevent moisture ingress that could damage fibers .
- UV-resistant and rugged outer sheaths: Ensure long-term durability in aerial, duct, or direct-burial installations .
- Reinforcement materials: Steel wires or fiber-reinforced plastics provide tensile st...
