Overview of Fiber Infrastructure in PNG

Papua New Guinea has significantly upgraded its fiber optic infrastructure with the Coral Sea Cable System (CS 2), a 4,700 km submarine cable linking Port Moresby to Sydney, Australia, and Honiara, Solomon Islands. The system uses a four fiber-pair core, providing up to 20 Tbps capacity to PNG, with initial installed capacity at 200 Gbps. This backbone enables high-speed connectivity for urban centers and supports expansion into rural areas . Local contractors like Cetelnet provide end-to-end fiber services, including network design, trenching, aerial deployment, splicing, testing, and maintenance. They serve telecommunications providers, government, healthcare, education, and industrial sectors, ensuring reliable deployment of both backbone and last-mile fiber networks .
