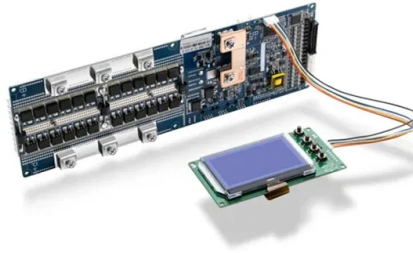


PoE switch burns network cable



AI Overview

A PoE switch can burn a network cable if the cable is incompatible, damaged, or if the switch or connected device malfunctions, causing excessive current or overheating.

Common Causes

1. Cable Type and Quality Not all Ethernet cables are suitable for PoE. Cables made from copper-clad aluminum (CCA) have higher resistance and can overheat under PoE load, especially over long runs or with high-power standards like 802.3bt. Ideal cables are Cat5e, Cat6, or Cat6a with pure copper conductors and 23-24 AWG wire gauge. Shielded cables (e.g., F/UTP) dissipate heat better and reduce interference, lowering the risk of burning . 2. Non-Standard or Passive PoE Devices Passive PoE switches deliver voltage without checking if the connected device supports PoE. If a device is not compatible, the cable can carry excessive current, potentially melting the insulation or damaging the switch and device . 3. Short Circuits or Faulty Connections Short circuits caused by damaged cables, faulty RJ45 connectors, water ingress, or dust can trigger rapid current surges. High-quality PoE switches with IEEE 802.3af/at/bt compliance usually detect shorts and cut power, but cheap or non-standard switches may fail to respond quickly, leading to cable overheating or port damage . 4. Overcurrent or Overload If the powered device draws more power than the switch port can safely supply, or if multiple high-power devices exceed the switch's PoE budget, the cable can overheat. This is more likely with long cable runs or thin wires, which increase resistance and heat generation .
