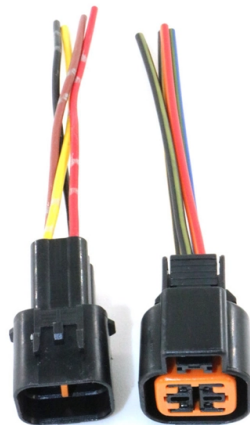


Power Consumption of Single-Mode Fiber Optic Transceivers
