The fiber cable color code helps technicians identify fibers, avoid errors, and complete installations faster. OM3 is a laser-optimized multimode fiber (LOMMF) designed for high-speed networks using VCSELs (Vertical-Cavity Surface-Emitting Lasers). The aqua color (hex: #00B6C1) is instantly recognizable and signals support for 10, 40, or 100 Gb/s over short distances — up to 300 meters at 10G.
