A projector optical module emits light by directing a high-intensity source through color modulation and micro-mirror or LCD elements, which then focus the image through a projection lens onto a screen.

Core Components of a Projector Optical Module

- **Light Source:** Modern projectors use LEDs, lasers, or high-intensity discharge (HID) lamps to generate bright white light. LEDs and lasers offer long lifetimes, high color saturation, and energy efficiency, while HID lamps provide very high brightness levels .
- **Color Modulation:** The white light is split into red, green, and blue channels using dichroic mirrors, color wheels, or filters. In DLP projectors, a Digital Micromirror Device (DMD) modulates light by tilting millions of tiny mirrors to reflect light toward or away from the lens, creating pixels of varying intensity . In LCD projectors, each color passes through a corresponding LCD panel, where pixels act as shutters to form monochrome images that are later recombined .
- **Optical Path and Lenses:** After modulation, the light is recombined (if split) and directed through a projection lens system. Lenses focus the light and correct distortions, ensuring a sharp, full-color image on the screen .
- **Projection:** The modulated and focused light exits the lens as a coherent image, with brightness, color, and resolution determined by the light source, modulation device, and optical design .
