Relay Protection in Electrical Systems

Protective relays are automatic devices designed to detect abnormal conditions in electrical circuits, such as overcurrent, overvoltage, under-frequency, or reverse power flow, and trigger circuit breakers to isolate the faulty section (). They act as the first line of defense to prevent equipment damage and maintain system stability (). Relays can be electromechanical, static, or digital/numerical, with modern numerical relays combining multiple protection functions, self-testing, and communication capabilities for supervisory control (). Proper coordination and setting of relays ensure selective tripping, minimizing disruption to healthy parts of the system (). Types of relays include:

- Overcurrent relays: Trip when current exceeds a set threshold.
- Voltage relays: Respond to abnormal voltage levels.
- Differential relays: Detect differences between incoming and outgoing currents in transformers or generators.
- Distance relays: Protect transmission lines by measuring impedance.
