

Requirements for cable trays and ducts in power plants

Cable trays and ducts in power plants must ensure mechanical strength, proper spacing, grounding, corrosion protection, and compliance with electrical and safety standards.

Design and Installation Principles

Cable trays are used for laying MV and LV power, control, instrumentation, and specialty cables. They must be supported on cantilever brackets or hangers at specified intervals, typically not exceeding 2 meters along the tray centerline, and vertical supports in risers at 1-meter intervals to maintain structural integrity and limit deflection under full load . Trays should run parallel to walls and electrical panels, with a minimum vertical clearance of 400 mm between adjacent trays and 300 mm above switchgear panels . Ducts and conduits are used where additional protection is required, such as in high-traffic areas or for sensitive instrumentation cables. Proper segregation of power, control, and instrumentation cables is essential to reduce electromagnetic interference (EMI) and ensure EMC compliance .

Materials and Corrosion Protection

Cable trays are typically fabricated from hot-dip galvanized steel, aluminum, or fiber-reinforced plastic (FRP), depending on environmental conditions . In corrosive areas, such as battery rooms or chemical houses, trays should be epoxy-painted or acid-resistant. All metal components must be bonded and effectively grounded to provid...
