

Requirements for electrical distribution boxes at new construction sites

Site Selection and Placement

Enclosure and Material

The enclosure must be made of fire-resistant materials, such as iron or other insulating materials, to provide ventilation, heat dissipation, rainproofing, and fire protection . For outdoor or harsh environments, the box should have a minimum IP55 rating to protect against dust and water jets . Steel enclosures are preferred for durability, while plastic may be used for indoor setups .
