Proper installation can significantly reduce electromagnetic interference, prevent fire hazards, and improve overall efficiency. The NEC has a requirement for ladder-type cable trays. Here's what you need to know: Cable Types: Only use. maintain spacing or to keep cables in place when the tray is ect the minimum bend radius for cables as they exit the bottom of the cable tray. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray cont d for instrumentation and control applications that require.
