Overview

Anyone working on or near cable tray systems, especially those carrying live electrical cables, should be properly trained. This training needs to cover electrical safety, lockout/tagout procedures, working at height, and the specific safety requirements for cable. Because many cable trays are mounted overhead, installation and maintenance work often happens on ladders, scaffolds, or lifts.
