

Risk Points of Primary Distribution Boxes



Overview

Slow Drains: If sinks, toilets, or bathtubs are draining slowly, it may indicate a problem with the distribution box. **Busbars:** These are solid strips of copper or aluminum that transfer electricity from the main source to the individual circuits inside the box. **Fuses** melt when too much current. Many suppliers have paper or cardboard distribution boxes that are designed for use in laboratory, pharmacy, patient care areas or sterile storage areas. They serve as the intermediary between the septic tank and the drain field, ensuring that effluent is evenly distributed across the leach lines. A distribution box — also called a D-box, junction box, or header box — is a small concrete, fiberglass, or plastic chamber typically 12 to 24 inches in diameter.
