Overview

Rusumo Bridge is an international bridge across the Kagera River linking Rwanda and Tanzania. Designed by Luigi Corradi and assembled previously in Turin, Italy. This year, three teams of 30 dedicated WSP volunteers are continuing our longstanding partnership with Bridges to Prosperity, building trail bridges in some of Rwanda's most isolated regions. They will support three builds, including the Nyiravugiza Suspension Bridge which will span 101 meters.
