Underground Installation Guidelines

When installing fiber optic cables underground, the conduit is usually buried 1-1.2 meters (3-4 feet) deep to minimize the risk of accidental damage from digging or surface activities. In regions with extreme cold, cables may need to be buried deeper to prevent frost penetration and maintain cable integrity . A conduit or innerduct is often used to protect the cable, and a detectable marker tape is placed above the conduit, typically no more than 300 mm (12 inches) below the surface, to warn future excavators .

Aerial Installation Considerations

For aerial fiber optic cables, the minimum height above ground is generally determined by local electrical and safety codes, as well as mechanical load considerations. While specific heights can vary, cables must be high enough to prevent accidental contact by pedestrians, vehicles, or equipment. Frequent clamping and support are recommended to prevent sagging and maintain the cable's mechanical integrity .
