

Safety Measures for Laying Optical Cables on 35kV Towers



Overview

This includes hard hats to protect against falling objects, safety glasses to prevent eye injuries from flying debris, gloves to protect hands from sharp edges and chemicals, and high - visibility vests for better visibility in the work area.
