

Secondary distribution box directly connected to load



Overview

Laterals can be directly connected to main trunks, but are more commonly protected by protective devices such as fuses, re-closers, or automatic sectionalizers. Overhead laterals use pole-mounted distribution transformers to serve customers and underground laterals use pad. Primary distribution systems consist of feeders that deliver power from distribution substations to distribution transformers. A feeder usually begins with a feeder breaker at the distribution substation. Many feeders leave substation in a concrete ducts and are routed to a nearby pole. Primary distribution lines carry this medium voltage power to distribution transformers located near the customer's. This document shows the methods and requirements for installing PG&E-owned, underground service cables in customer-owned, residential, terminating facilities. This can include utility interactive PV systems, wind systems, fuel cells, energy storage systems, DC microgrids and.
