- **Audit PoE Usage Regularly:** Check which ports are actively using PoE and verify power consumption to ensure no unnecessary power is being supplied .
- **Follow Manufacturer Guidelines:** Different switch vendors provide specific commands or GUI options to disable PoE per port. For example, Cisco uses power in...
