

Spacing between layers of multi-layer cable trays



AI Overview

The minimum vertical spacing between stacked cable trays should be 150 millimeters, while horizontal spacing between parallel trays should be at least 0.6 meters for maintenance and airflow.

Vertical Spacing

For multi-layer or stacked cable trays, the minimum vertical clearance between the upper and lower trays should be 150 millimeters (6 inches). This spacing ensures proper ventilation, heat dissipation, and allows room for future cable additions or rearrangements. Adequate vertical spacing also reduces the risk of cable interference and maintains structural integrity of the tray system .

Horizontal Spacing

When installing two cable trays in parallel at the same height, the horizontal distance should be no less than 0.6 meters (approximately 2 feet). This clearance provides sufficient access for maintenance, inspection, and prevents cables from touching, which could lead to short circuits or electromagnetic interference (EMI). For power and signal cable trays, a minimum horizontal separation of 0.5 meters is recommended to reduce EMI, though this can be reduced to 0.3 meters if the trays are shielded .
